Drop In Day June 21st- Current CS Kinders through 5th Graders

The last day of Creative Sprouts Kindergarten AND the LWSD is June 20th (school year was extended due to snow day) and it is a half day. After school care will NOT be available June 20th for anyone. There is, however, full day drop in care available Friday the 21st. We may go on a field trip that day to a local park. Space is very limited so please let me know via our Google registration form if you would like care for your child on the 21st. I will sign people up on a first come, first served basis.

Summer Camp 2018- Time Travelers- Current CS Kinders through 5th Graders

This summer, we will travel to the past and the future throughout our summer camp themes! We will go on tons of fun field trips and have exciting activities at the school as well. To reserve your spot in a camp, you must fill out the registration form via Google Forms and pay the non-refundable deposit necessary (see below). We will process the electronic Google registration forms on March 9th based on our priority scale (see below). After March 9th, you can still turn in summer camp registration forms, but they will be processed on a first come, first served basis, regardless of our priority scale. We are no longer charging separate materials & field trip fees. All of these activities are now included in the camp tuition.

Drop In Days Sept 5-7 “Kindergarten Family Connections Week”-

Current CS Kinders, New CS Kinders & Kinders going to public elementary schools

On September 5, 6 & 7, we will offer care for Kindergartners who don't start school until September 10th. Because we will have our 1st-5th graders before and after school these days, we will only be offering care during normal LWSD school hours of 9:20am-3:50pm and Wednesday until 1:40pm. If your Kindergartner is signed up for our before and/or after school care, they may use extended hours prior to 9:20am and after 3:50pm **only** on days they are signed up for before or after care. For example: If you are signed up for after school care on Thursdays, but not Wednesdays or Fridays, your child may only stay beyond 3:50pm on the 6th, NOT the 5th or 7th. If you are not signed up for Kindergarten before and/or after care, the cost for these shorter days is \$50 per day. There is no charge for these days for students who will be starting CS Kindergarten Sept 2018. We will go on field trips to local Kirkland parks these days. Parents are free to pick up and drop off children at field trip locations at any time. There is no charge for Creative Sprouts Kindergarten students, but you still must sign up for these days if you need care those days. Creative Sprouts is closed September 3 & 4. <p>If you are registering for less than 6 camps- 25% deposit of tuition for each week of camp is due by April 25th.</p> <p>If you are registering for 6 or more camps- 10% deposit of tuition for each week of camp is due by April 25th.</p> <p>For all camps- <i>The remainder of tuition due after deposits have been paid will be due in advance on the 25th of the month prior to the camp.</i></p> <p>Camp 1: -tuition remainder is due May 25th</p> <p>Camp 2,3,4,5,6: -tuition remainder is due June 25th</p> <p>Camp 7,8,9,10: -tuition remainder is due July 25th</p>	<p>Here is the system we use to determine who has priority when we enroll our classes/camps:</p> <p>1st- Current Students (if we have more students register than we have room in the class or camp, we will give priority based on length of time at our school). Students who sign up for full weeks of camp will have priority over those who sign up for partial weeks.</p> <p>2nd- Siblings of current students</p> <p>3rd- Past students</p> <p>4th- New students</p>
